CITY SHAPER 2019 FIRST LEGO League Season

1. To qualify for funding from FIRST Robotics Canada, new teams must fill out the following form and return it via email to first@yfl-fyl.ca **AFTER** team registration officially opens on May 7th at 12 p.m. and before September 27th, 2019.
APPLICATIONS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IF THEY ARE FULLY COMPLETE WITH OFFICIAL 5-DIGIT TEAM # FOR THE "CITY SHAPER" 2019 FIRST LEGO LEAGUE SEASON.

It is a requirement that you have **two (2) coaches** dedicated to running the team and that they commit to at least 4-6 hours a week of time with the children and compete at a qualifying tournament in November/December.

Note: There will be a maximum of 10 grants given to any one school board/organization and a maximum of 60 grants in all for the province of Ontario.

It is understood that this grant is to be used to add a team to an existing school/organization (if your organization already had one or two teams in the 2018 INTO ORBIT season you would have one MORE team in 2019) **OR** to a new school/organization (school/organization will hereafter be referred to as simply "school" and is defined as being an organization funded/mentored by a school, by a registered home school, or mentored by a recognized company or community group such as the Girl Guides, Scouts, CAGIS, Girls Inc., etc.). **Funding will include reimbursement for \$500**, which offsets some of the costs of running your FIRST LEGO League team in its first year.
