



## Contact Tracing Policy

### In the event of a covid-positive scenario

- Lead mentors should let the Tournament Director / *FIRST* Robotics Canada Event Lead know if they or any attendees from their team test positive for COVID-19 after the event
- Volunteers should let the Tournament Director / *FIRST* Robotics Canada Event Lead know if they test positive for COVID-19 after the event
- If contacted by an attendee, the Tournament Director / *FIRST* Robotics Canada Event Lead Staff Member will share all pertinent details with *FIRST* Robotics Canada COVID-19 Task Force
  - The *FIRST* Robotics Canada COVID-19 Task Force will provide guidance and appropriate message for communication to the Tournament Director / *FIRST* Robotics Canada Event Lead
  - The Tournament Director / *FIRST* Robotics Canada Event Lead will send a communication to all attendees.
  - If it is possible to isolate a positive case to certain portions of the event (e.g. positive attendee only sat in the stands), these details will be shared in the communication
  - No names or identifying information will be provided regarding the person who tested positive.
- People with questions will be referred to the local Public Health Unit if they have questions regarding where to get a test, what self-isolation means, etc.
