### **August 24th, 2022**

### **April 4th, 2022**

- Pre-Event Screening Protocol: Updated to reflect the latest screening protocol from the Province

### **March 29th, 2022**

- Event Capacity & Attendance Limits: Team Attendance Limit for the Ontario Provincial Championship is updated. All other events are finalized

### **March 11th, 2022**

- Respiratory Etiquette and Hand Hygiene Policy: Removed reference to shouting
- Event Check-in and Proof of Vaccination Verification Protocol: Removed incorrect reference to photo ID being required
- Volunteer Check-in and Proof of Vaccination Verification Protocol: Removed incorrect reference to photo ID being required
- Event Capacity & Attendance Limits: Team Attendance Limit for University of Waterloo, York University, Windsor-Essex, North Bay Events updated
- Physical Distancing: Updated the limit of team members in the pit area to 8, added references to pit lanyards. Removed guidance against entering the pit areas of other teams. Removed note about signage displaying room capacities. Clarifications on the

type of approved (fist-bump, elbow-taps, etc.) and unapproved physical contact (hugs, handshakes, high-fives, etc.)

- Contact Tracing Policy: Updated event list and contacts; updated guidance on communication protocols after a positive test

#### **February 25th, 2022**

- Vaccination Policy: Updated to remove references to outdated Provincial Policies
- Event Capacity & Attendance Limits: Team Attendance Limit for Humber College finalized, approximate date of finalization for Waterloo and York is set
- Food & Drink Policy: Updated to remove reference to buffet style meals

- Event Capacity & Attendance Limits: Team Attendance Limit for Humber College Event updated
- Vaccination Policy & Event Check-in Policy: Updated to match newest Provincial Guidelines regarding mandatory use of enhanced vaccine certificates with official QR codes, and vaccine medical exemptions being verified using official enhanced vaccine certificates with QR codes
